PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE | February 2023

We hope everyone has orchids that are in blooms, and you are adjusting to the variability of February weather in Ohio. I am writing this President's Message because of the resignation of our President, Amy Stanley, and the March 1st resignation of our Vice-President, Jessica Badger. Both Amy and Jessica are resigning due to time constraints and feel that they are unable to give COOS the time it deserves. We regret their departure from the Board, and thank them for their service, while looking forward to their ongoing active support and participation in Central Ohio Orchid Society.

In accordance with Section 4 of the COOS Constitution the Board will appoint a new President, who will then nominate to the Board a new Vice-President – stay tuned. On a brighter note, Edgar Stehli of *Wind Swept in Time Orchids* will be our February speaker on the topic of Encyclias, and will also have plants for sale. The room at Franklin Park Conservatory (FPC) will open at 6PM for set-up and social time, the ZOOM connection will be activated between 6 and 6:30, the 'Beginner's Corner' will start at 6:30, and the business/speaker segment of the meeting starts at 7PM.

We are also aware of issues associated with the moving of locations on short notice and technical issues with the ZOOM segment of the meetings. We have little control of being relocated by FPC and will continue to send out email notices as soon as we are aware of the situation. With switching also comes a lack of technical equipment and support. So, to address this, plus improve the ZOOM meeting quality, we have purchased our own equipment (camera, projector & screen, cables, etc.) Going forward this will provide us with a technical independence from FPC's equipment, plus familiarity with the equipment for improved broadcasting. Edgar Stehli of **Windswept in Time Orchids**



My interest in orchids began when I was just six or seven years old. I found a plant growing in the roadside ditch near our house in North East Ohio. When my father got home from work, I dragged him over to see my discovery. He said “Oh! That’s an orchid.” My first orchid find was a *Spiranthes* (probably *cernua*). A few years later my family drove to Alaska and back. On that trip, I found a *Calypso bulbosa* in Wyoming and several other

orchids in Alaska and Canada.

While in high school, I began growing some tropical orchids, and soon had a small collection. While in my final year at Case Western Reserve University my orchid collection moved to Florida with my parents. Sadly, I never saw them again (the orchids that is!). Also in my last year, I met Kim Sante who was working at the Cleveland Garden Center, now known as the Cleveland Botanical Garden. Eventually Kim and I were married in Kenya Africa. Shortly after we were married, we built a sun room on the corner of our house. This of course allowed my orchid collection to get a little out of hand. Finally in 1999 we began selling our plants to area florists, then through the orchid shows. We called our new business – Windswept in Time Orchids. We now attend close to fifteen shows a year, where our plants and exhibits have won many awards.

Paphiopedilum Jenna Marie ‘Sparkle’ x Red Dominion ‘Perfection’
Grown by Dennis Eifel

Dennis grows this lovely complex Paph hybrid in his greenhouse. Complex or “Bulldog” Paphs need a moisture-retaining, but well draining medium such as small bark mixed with chunks of sponge rock. They should be watered once or twice weekly, never being allowed to dry out completely, and fed “weakly weekly.” Complex hybrids enjoy somewhat brighter light than mottled-leaf Paphs, but should not be put out in direct summer sun—think brighter than a Phalaenopsis but more shaded than a Cattleya. They do well in intermediate conditions, and our central Ohio fall temperatures give them the perfect little nightly chill to help them set buds for winter blooming.

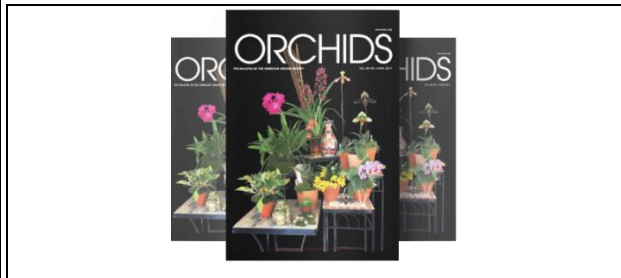
