Plant of the Month

Catt. mossiae Grown by Tessie Steelman

Tessie grows this plant outside from spring to fall under a 50% Aluminet cover and waters it daily. She fertilizes with Miracle Grow twice a month until Sept. When the temperature drops to below 50 degrees all her orchids go into the basement growing area. She uses multicolor LED lights with fans going 24/7. She uses a high powered Petra sprayer which waters with a very fine mist sprayer.

January 18 Meeting Deflasking

Join Dennis Steinbeck at 6:30 pm at the Franklin Park Conservatory, Wells Barn. Dennis will be demonstrating deflasking orchids and **will offer a plant sale.**

Dennis Steinbeck is a lifelong gardener, but it wasn't until a friend gave him a struggling Cattleya that he went all in for orchids. After blooming that plant, it kicked off a hobby turned obsession that led to him opening Flask & Flora, one of Ohio's few dedicated orchid nurseries. While only starting 4 years ago, he regularly travels around the world to meet with growers and learn more about the specific orchids they grow in order to best culture plants here in the Midwest.

Dennis now focuses mostly in breeding Cattleyas, Paphs, and Oncidiums but grows a wide range of odd and interesting genera as well. He is preparing to build two (mostly) permanent greenhouses in the next month, so you'll be able to visit him at his place near the Conservatory all through the winter.


