Paph. armeniacum 'Orchid Court' CCM/AOS Grown by Tennis Maynard

Tennis grows Paph. armeniacum wet year-round, especially so when in spike. It is in a fine bark mix with some crushed oyster shell for calcium. He puts it outside in early spring for hot summers and cold falls/winters, leaving it outside until temperatures are regularly down to 40 degrees or so as long as possible. They do take more light than most people think, cattleya level at least, broken in gradually. **Congratulations, Tennis for growing January's Plant of the Month!**
