This lovely Bulbophyllum is native to Indonesia, Philippines, and New Guinea. The flower is a bright yellow-green with a sharply contrasting lip. Tennis grows this plant in warm conditions in his greenhouse, giving it lots of light, regular feeding, and high humidity. Tennis grows this species in straight Coconut Husk Chips, in plastic pots.


