AUGUST PLANT OF THE MONTH



Habenaria erichmichelii Grown by Edna & David Markley

EDNA: I grow my *Habenaria erichmichelii* in Orchiata pine bark, classic size, along with chopped sphagnum moss, charcoal, and pearlite.

Dormant period: Towards the end of November, the leaves dry up. At that point I stop watering completely.

Growing period: around April, I start to see new growth and when it progresses to about 1 inch or so, I start watering again along the edge of the pot. I use MSU fertilizer weakly (about 1/4 tsp per gallon of water) applied every other week. I grow them under lights (intermediate to warm) until the beginning of June, then bring them outside under shade.

Our objective is to encourage a larger audience to appreciate these natural treasures and to join us in our effort to preserve them and their habitat. Many of your photos will be published in a dedicated edition of the Native Orchid Conference Journal. Please join us and share your joy.

Eligibility - anyone may participate; Adult or Youth (grade 12 or lower when photo was taken)

Timing - submissions accepted immediately through November 15, 2022

How to submit - email up to 3 images to nocphotos2022@gmail.com

Entry criteria -

- Image must be of native orchids (species or natural hybrids) in their natural habitat
- Image may be a single flower, a full or partial inflorescence, multiple plants, a habitat overview (orchids must be discernable) or a close-up of flower features
- · Image must have been taken in the US or Canada
- Do not include props or artificial backgrounds
- Include photographer's name, contact info, name of orchid(s), identify the image & specify if Adult or Youth
- Delete metadata or any reference to specific location of plants
- If image was previously published, provide details
- Only basic adjustments permitted (flowers should appear as they did when seen in nature)

Selection for publication - entries will be evaluated based on adherence to the above criteria, composition & esthetics, proper plant ID, and educational or conservation relevance.

Recognition - selected entries will be featured in an exclusive edition of the *Native Orchid Conference Journal*. Images remain the property of the photographer who retains copyright privileges. Photographers will be contacted and given an opportunity to provide anecdotal information about their entries which will be included in the Journal.

Special Award - three entries from each age group will earn the photographers a one year, free membership in the Native Orchid Conference.


