**Hands-on Repotting Clinic/Workshop**  
**Thursday, April 21<sup>st</sup> at Franklin Park Conservatory**  
**Beginner's Corner 7:30pm – Meeting starts at 8pm**

Ever had trouble with repotting that badly overgrown plant? Does the thought of different potting mixes make you want to head for the hills? What about dividing your orchids? Fear no more and come to our meeting on Thursday 4/21. We will have a hands-on repotting clinic. Bring those plants in need of TLC, some spare clean pots, and some bark or coconut mix, or moss. Our on-site orchid experts will help you get that plant ready for the summer growing season.

Soaking the plants overnight will help to minimize any root damage in the process...especially for those orchids in clay pots. Pull them out of the water an hour or two before the meeting and let them drain, so you don't soak your car seat. 😊

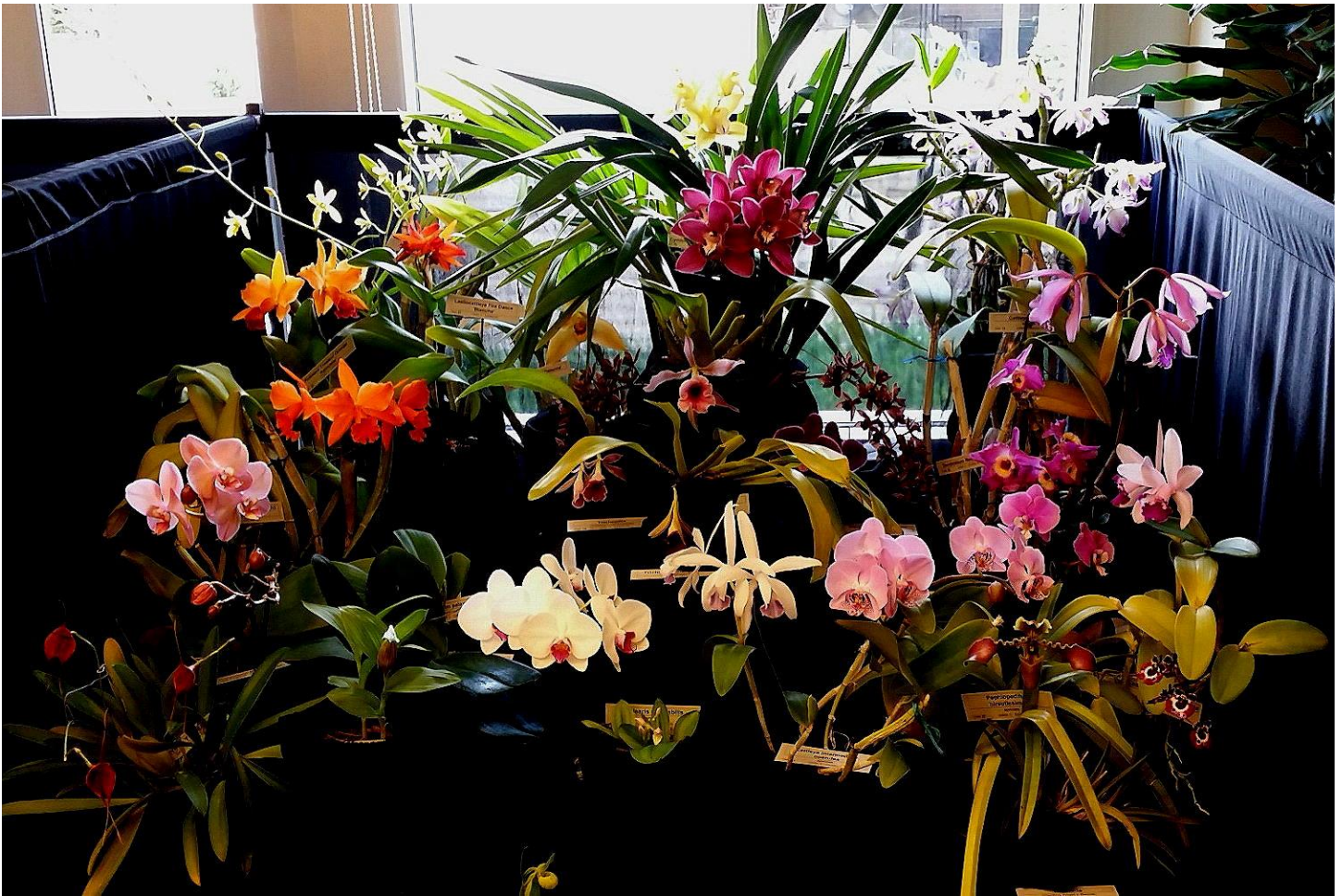
