President's Message

While putting together a talk to present to the Miami Valley Orchid Society, I paused to give thought to including some mention of possible sources for plants. I got to thinking that quite a number of our own members are newer growers and might appreciate a few tips in this area as well.

The best options, of course, are attending the huge sale events like Santa Barbara International Orchid Show in March, the Chicagoland Orchid Festival in September, Tamiami Orchid Festival in January, and the Redlands Orchid Festival in May. These are events which include large numbers of out-of-state and international vendors, from such places as Central and South America, Africa, Japan, Taiwan, the Philippines, mainland Asia, Germany, and others.

A trip to these events is always memorable, and the Chicagoland Orchid Festival is doable by car, though probably would require an overnight stay there. The Redlands event is indescribable. A huge park entirely filled with tent after tent of tables of orchids for sale. It can take some people two days to see and shop them all. Of course, I'm sure it will surprise no-one that I run through it in a half-day or a little more. After all, that leaves all that much more time for margaritas and the pool in Lauderdale!

The best parts of attending these events are: the ability to see the plants you're choosing and pick out the best ones for your collection; and the fact that you can preorder from the vendors for pickup at the show, without the need to hassle with the costly CITES and phytosanitary paperwork, which the dealers have already done for their cargo of plants. And if you do go, you can bring back your plants in person, or, if you are flying, do what I do: ship them home to yourself USPS priority mail and they will arrive in two to three days - no muss, no fuss!

What many people do NOT know is that most of these foreign vendors will accept orders for plants which they will SHIP from the event locations after arrival in the country. This allows orchidophiles to shop these international plants without having to travel to these events, yet receive the plants through the mail with only the normal shipping charges. So if you absolutely CAN'T go to these (and I strongly urge that you do indeed go for a once-in-a-lifetime experience you will want to repeat year after year), get online and look up the vendors lists for these events, contact them (sometimes they will even have links to the catalogs on the event pages) and get their listings and order exotic, unusual, and hard-to-get (here) plants and broaden your horizons - and your collections. The rewards are limitless!!
