February Meeting

Topic: Franklin Park Conservatory's Orchids – Behind the Scenes
Thursday, Feb. 21st at Franklin Park Conservatory
Beginner's Corner 7:30pm – Meeting starts at 8pm

We have a very special speaker and event for our February meeting. Garet Martin of Franklin Park Conservatory will give a behind the scenes view of the Conservatory's annual orchid exhibition.

"Orchids: Behind the Scenes" will cover what is involved with designing, installing and maintaining the orchids exhibition--as well as some insight into the current incantation of the show (which Garet says has been somewhat challenging). As a special treat, Garet will provide the society with a personal tour of the exhibition!

Those of you who are familiar with FPC's annual exhibition know it is a joy to behold, and this year they have really raised the bar, focusing on orchids hanging from elevated baskets! This is your chance for a free, private after-hours tour!

Garet Martin serves as the Horticulture Exhibitions Designer at Franklin Park Conservatory and Botanical Gardens. In this role, he has the honor of creating the seasonal exhibitions visitors experience throughout the calendar year. From selecting poinsettia varieties for the annual holiday exhibition, Conservatory Aglow, to creating unique layouts and hanging devices for the Orchid exhibition. Garet's extensive background in fine arts as well as his love--and knowledge--of plants makes him uniquely qualified to fill such a diverse and dynamic role. Garet received a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Studio Arts from Shawnee State University (Portsmouth, Ohio) and a Master of Fine Arts in Painting from Purdue University (West Lafayette, Indiana). Prior of taking on the position of Horticulture Exhibitions Designer, Garet worked in the realm of Higher Education, teaching Drawing, Painting, Printmaking and Installation Art at both Purdue University and Drake University (Des Moines, Iowa).
