June Meeting Repotting Clinic

Thursday, June 21st at Franklin Park Conservatory Beginner's Corner 7:30pm – Meeting starts at 8pm

It is June, and that means plants are going outside, roots are in growth mode, and it is a great time to repot! Help your orchids get a great start for the growing season and come to our annual Repotting Clinic on Thursday June 21st at Franklin Park Conservatory. The meeting will be in our normal space, the classrooms on the first floor behind the front desk.

Bring a few of your plants, some clean pots, and your preferred medium (Sphagnum moss, Fir bark, coconut husk, sponge rock, charcoal). We will have plenty of folks to share their knowledge on the process and help with your questions.

*Helpful tip: for many orchids, it is good to soak the roots overnight before you repot. This helps make the roots more pliable and can keep them from breaking when you remove the plant from the pot.

We also have a 6 Phalaenopsis plants, which can be repotted during the meeting and then someone in each group has a chance to take one home for free! Ken Mettler also has a few additional Phals for \$3.25 each.

SPEAKER'S DINNER: We will not have a speaker dinner this month.

VIRUS TEST KITS: We have a couple test kits to raffle at our June meeting. We also will discuss potentially ordering more for the society.

MEMBER PLANT SALE: We will have a member plant sale at our June 21 meeting. Please bring those extra plants and divisions to share! Remember 20% of proceeds are due to our Treasurer, Cheryl Early.
